HOW'S IT GOING?

We do need to be dependent on God to open doors, to help us talk about Jesus clearly, and to help us conduct our conversations with grace.

Below is a reminder of the evangelism "PR's"-

- **PRAY** for those we know who don't yet know Jesus AND pray for open doors for us to share
- PROCLAIM the message sensitively & clearly (talk about the Jesus we love)
- **PRIORITISE** spending time with people who don't yet know Jesus
- **PREPARE** how to have spiritual conversations
- PRACTICE having spiritual conversations
